Parkinsonian side effects (such as muscular rigidity, tremors, and impaired motor controls) are frequently encountered during treatment with typical anti-psychotic medication and to a lesser degree of atypical anti-psychotic medication. These drugs are prescribed to help people increase control over their own muscles and prevent stiffness.

- Dry mouth
- Sedation
- Constipation
- Blurred vision
- Urinary retention
